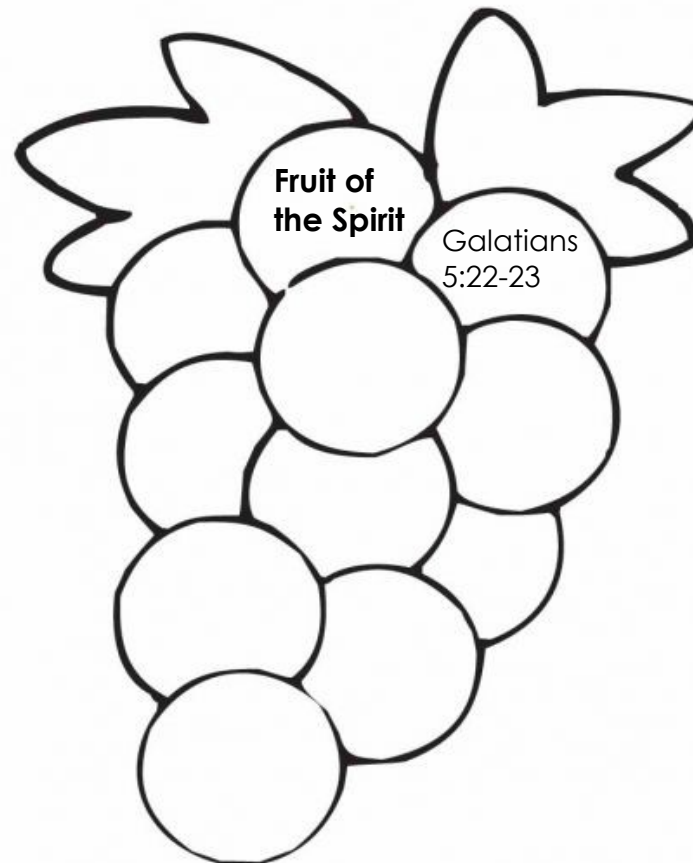
### Sunday Dinner Table Talk
