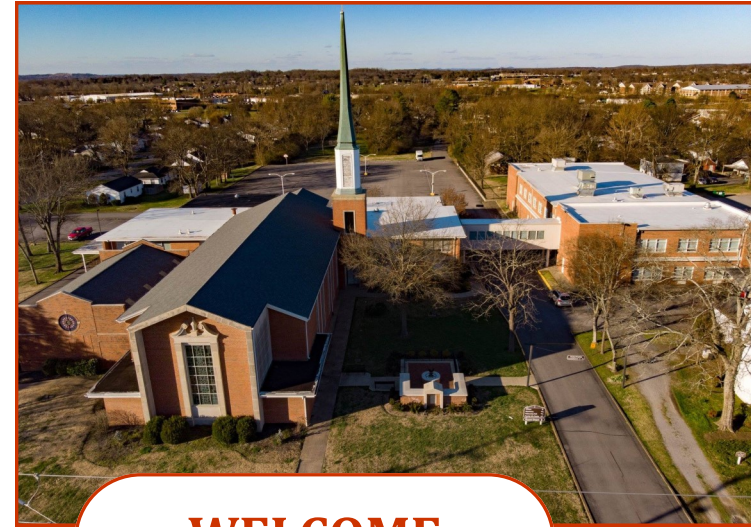

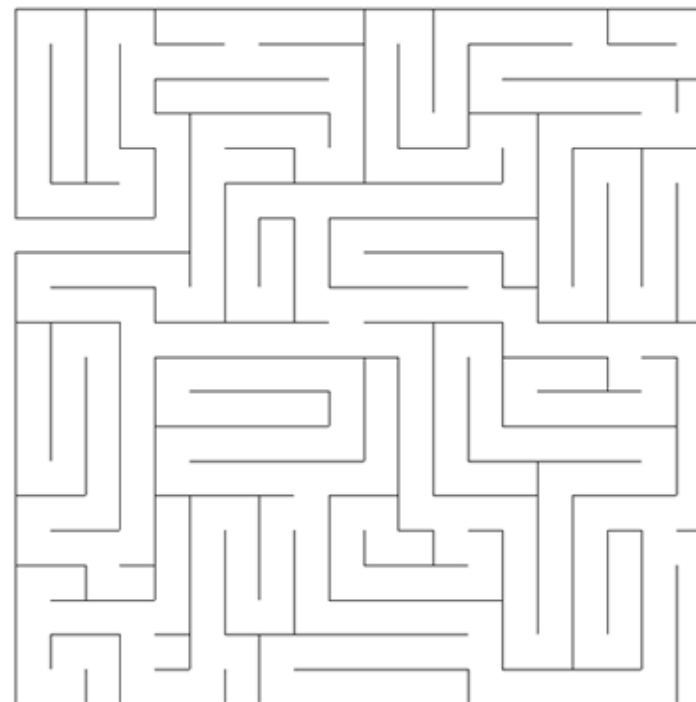
WELCOME
