Dr. Brené Brown on Perfectionism:

Perfectionism is not the same as striving to be your best. In fact, perfectionism is NOT about healthy achievement and growth. Perfectionism is about a false understanding that if we can just do everything perfectly then we will not have to deal with pain, blame, and shame.

Perfectionism is not self-improvement. Perfectionism is, at its core, about trying to earn approval and acceptance.

Perfectionism is self-destructive because:

- 1. It is an addictive belief system that has unattainable goals.
- 2. There is no such thing as perfect.
- 3. When we do experience shame, judgment, and blame, we often believe it is because we weren't perfect enough.


Feeling shamed, judged, and blamed are realities of the human experience. Self-compassion centers around cutting yourself some slack, being kind to yourself, and recognizing that the feeling of inadequacy is part of our humanity that every person experiences.
