UPDATED SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOR LEBANON FUMC

Worship

We may now use 33% of our Sanctuary capacity, or 130 persons/service. Please be sure when you enter the Sanctuary that you sit in the appropriate pews. At the 8:30 service we sit in the even-numbered pews, and at 11:00 we sit in the odd-numbered ones.

Make sure your family maintains a 6-foot distance from the next family/group in your pew throughout the service.

Masks are still required to cover nose and mouth at all times during worship, as that is the guideline for any service which incorporates congregational singing. You do not need to call ahead/save seats for worship at this time.

Children's Programming/Nursery

We have secured enough adult volunteers to offer a new format for children's spiritual formation from 9:50-10:30 AM. This will begin October 18.

Children will be divided into a PreK-2nd Grade group and a 3rd-6th Grade group. **Families will drop children off at the gate by the playground.**

The format will consist of two 20-minute segments, with one group participating in spiritual formation in the gym as the other group is having play/fellowship time (on the playground, weather permitting).

Protocols require masks for children three and up while indoors.

Nursery will be available during both worship services and from 9:50-10:30. This will also begin October 18.

Families will drop off infants through 3-year-olds at the Children's Entrance.

Sunday School/ Small Groups/Pastors Sunday School Class

We are continuing to empower all our groups to meet in ways that feel safe for everyone. **If your group would like to meet in person, reach out to Pastor Bucky and let him help you find an appropriate space for the size of your group.** There are fewer restrictions on outdoor gatherings, so groups are invited to reserve the Pavilion, Prayer Garden, Outdoor Chapel, and other accommodating outdoor spaces as desired.

For a season, your pastors will be leading a Sunday school class in the Fellowship Hall. This is for those who desire an in-person Sunday school class option but whose classes are not yet comfortable to meet in person, as well as for anyone else who does not have a class and/or would like to come. The protocol for this class will be to wear a mask in the building until you get to your seat in the Fellowship Hall; you may remove your mask once seated if you desire. Seating will be spaced six feet apart by family/household. This will begin October 18.
